**The Rochester Region includes the following Counties:** Chemung, Livingston, Monroe, Ontario, Schuyler, Seneca, Steuben, Wayne and Yates.

**The Syracuse Region includes the following Counties:** Broome, Chenango, Cortland, Cayuga, Herkimer, Jefferson, Lewis, Madison, Oneida, Onondaga, Oswego, St. Lawrence, Tioga and Tompkins.

**The Albany Region includes the following counties:** Albany, Clinton, Columbia, Delaware, Essex, Franklin, Fulton, Greene, Hamilton, Montgomery, Otsego, Rensselaer, Saratoga, Schenectady, Schoharie, Warren and Washington.

**The Hudson Valley Includes the following Counties:** Dutchess, Orange, Putnam, Rockland, Sullivan, Ulster and Westchester.
